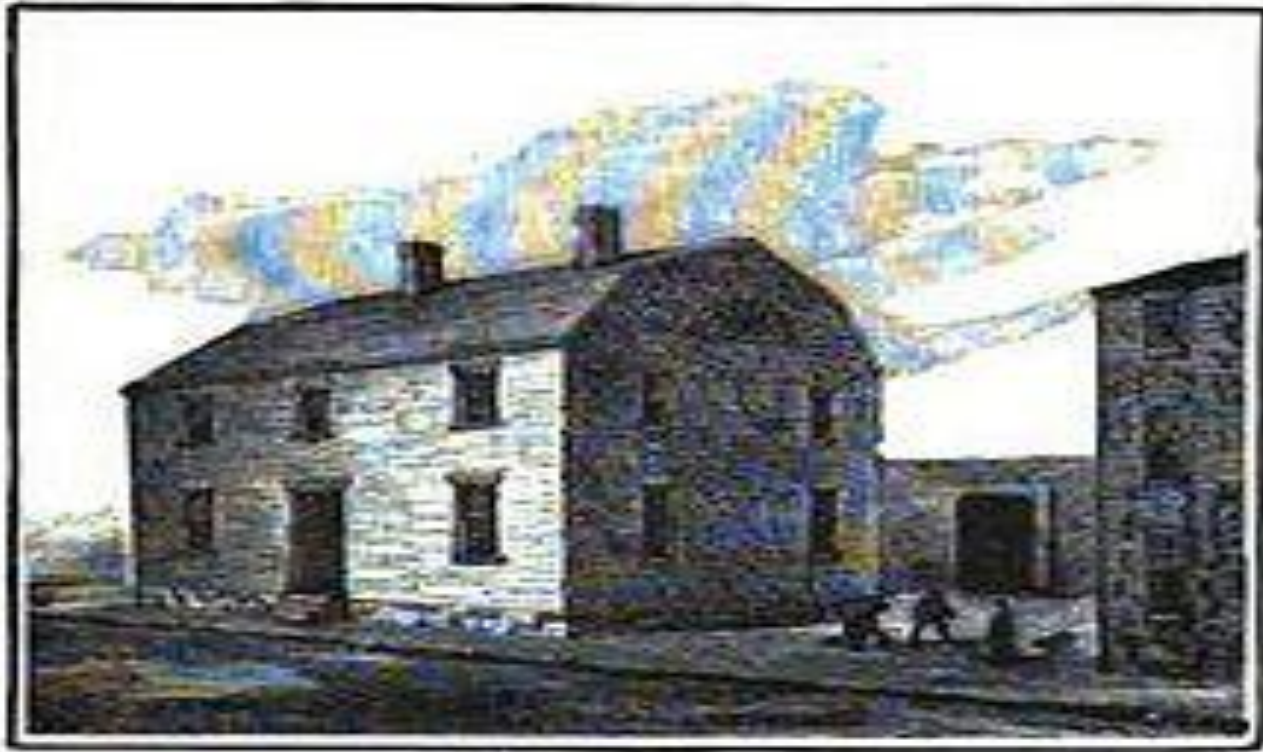

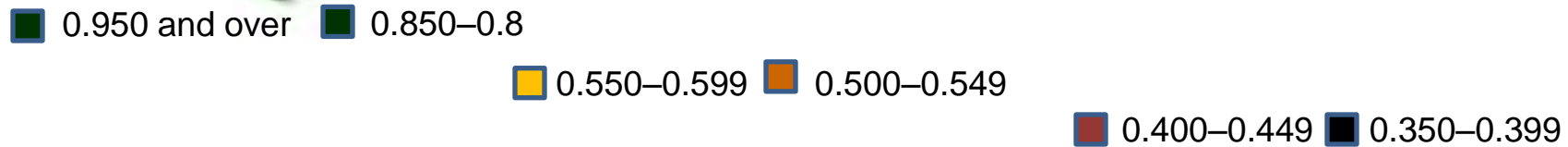
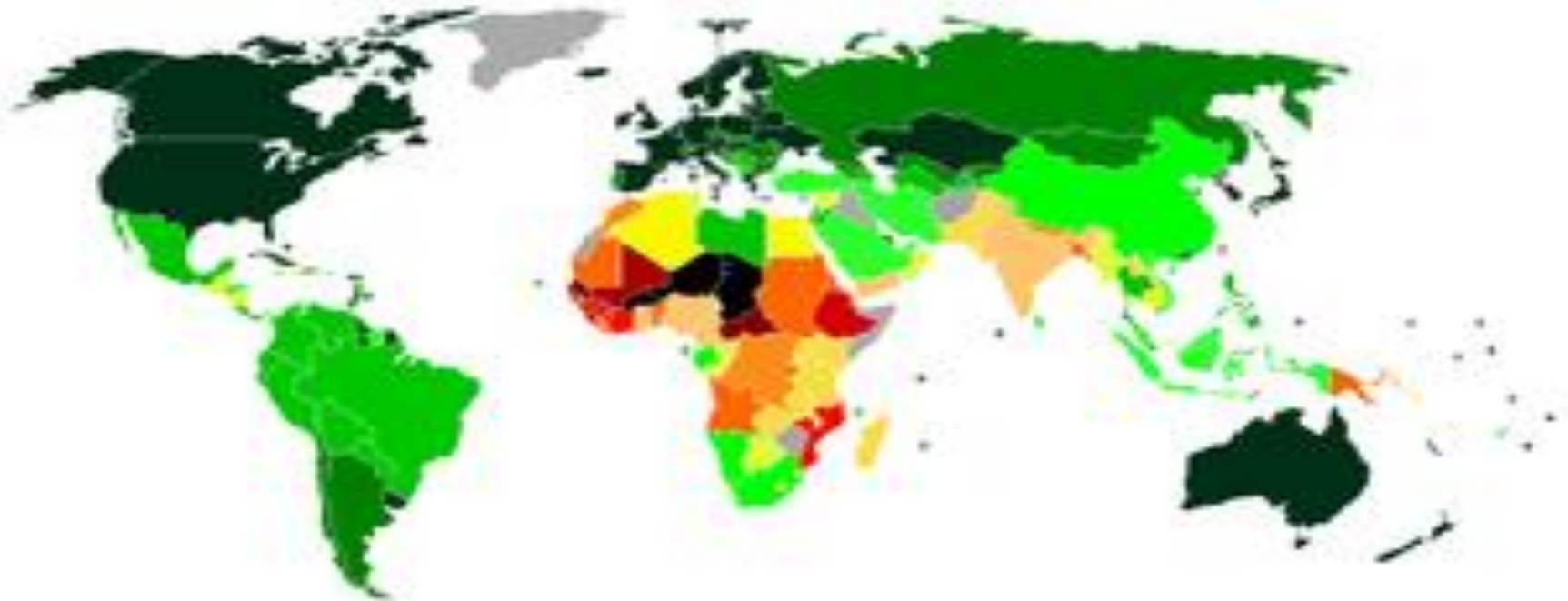


# First Open School House

# Key Learning Points

## 1. Learning is for Earning:

- educating the masses is for Employability.

## 2. Adoption of Technology:

- however beneficial, takes a very long time
- it is often rationed to maintain the class gap

## 3. Education has an elitist bias:

- recognize and fight it
- Education for developing “higher” potential is merely extending this bias
- spelling of higher is h-i-r-e.

## 4. Universal compulsory education:

- India is a late comer
- passing an act is not the same as being able to provide it
- needs radical overhaul

## 5. Equal opportunity in skills and knowledge

- Knowing that resulting capabilities will be distributed
- pre-requisite for a prosperous nation
