II. Assessment: Measure What Matters

- New and better ways to measure what matters
 - Diagnosis
 - Modify conditions of learning
 - Grading and accountability
 - Early and timely assessment enables intervention and remediation
- Real time diagnosis of strengths and weaknesses for any corrections
- Multiple stakeholders for designing, conducting, and using assessment
- Technology-based assessments can mass-customize information
- Leads to continuous improvement across entire system
- System "learns" about students' abilities and provides increasingly appropriate support
